## MINOT MAIN DEMOLITION & REBUILD

For 30 years, our Minot Main branch at 615 South Broadway has served as a landmark, but it's reached the end of its life. After decades of use, we face significant and expensive challenges, including HVAC, foundation and water issues, space limitations, and inefficient layouts. Demolishing the current building and rebuilding on the same lot allows us to invest in a building sized for the lot, with better drive-up access, improved parking, and room to grow.

We're excited and ready to begin this multi-year project. We'll start with demolition, followed by construction of a new building. Here's what you need to know about Minot branch access.

- The Minot Main branch will be closing, and the **last day for lobby access will be Friday, July 31. The drive-up will remain open through Friday, August 7**, but the ATM will be decommissioned and removed during this week.
- **We will open a Temporary Branch in our parking lot** behind Minot Main on **Monday, August 3rd**, that will be open throughout the construction project. The temporary branch will have a one-lane drive-up and teller line.
- All other staff regularly found at Minot Main, including the Town & Country Insurance Agency, are moving to a new location at 31st Ave SW in Minot.
- **The 31st Ave branch will open on Monday, August 10th**, with a teller line and self-service coin-counting machine, but no drive-up or ATM. . Prior to the building's opening date, credit union staff and lenders will be available by appointment.



Want to avoid construction? Visit the drive-ups at our South Minot and full-service Dakota Square locations, or come inside at Trinity Health and our new 31st Ave SW location.

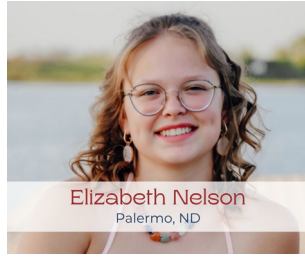
